What is your favourite part of teaching?

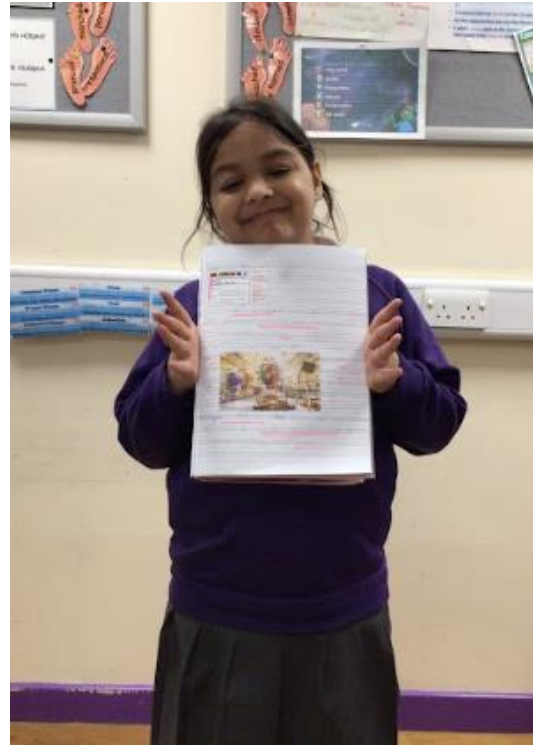
When my pupils achieve something they are aiming for.

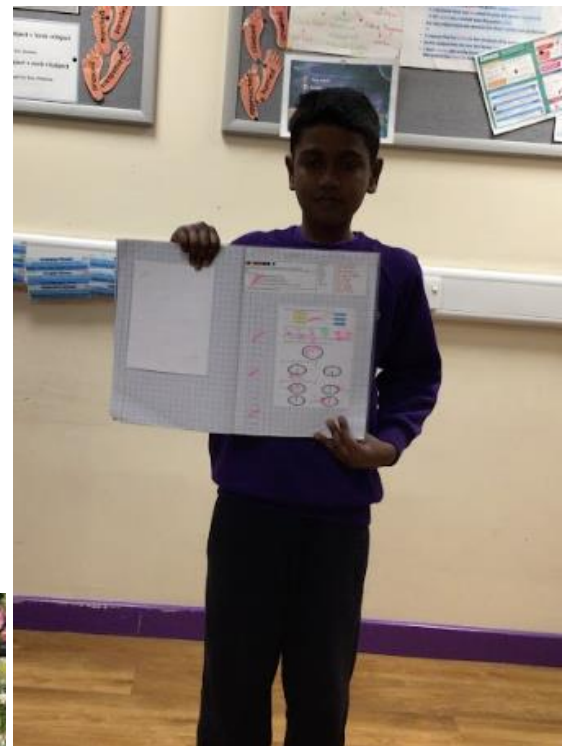

Congratulations on becoming King!

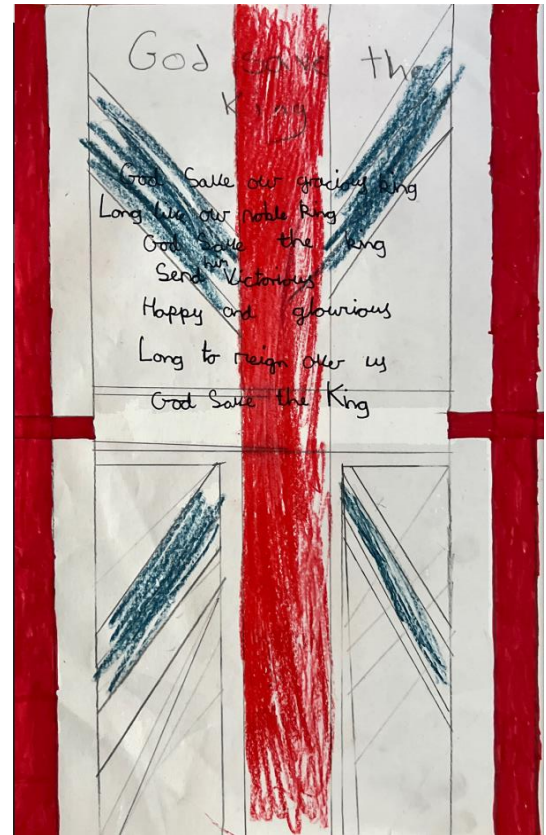
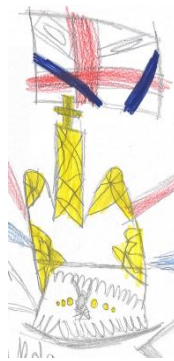
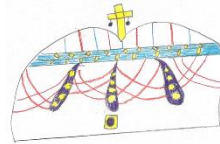

All About the King's Coronation

It started with King Athelsten and now King Charles III and Queen Camila reign. King Charles III and Queen Camila are now the new Monarchs of the United Kingdom. On Monday 8th May 2023, all schools in the United Kingdom had a day off in honour of the coronation.

In addition to this, King Charles III has two children: William and Harry. Furthermore, the king was crowned in what was billed as a slimmed-down coronation ceremony of just two hours. As a state occasion, King Charles III's coronation was paid with public funds. This is different to a royal wedding, which is a personal family moment with some public elements to it, so the cost is split between private and public funds. His coronation cost about £100 million altogether. It lasted for about three days.

Some people might ask, what is the tradition of the coronation? Well, it is a symbolic formality and does not signify the official beginning of the monarch's reign.

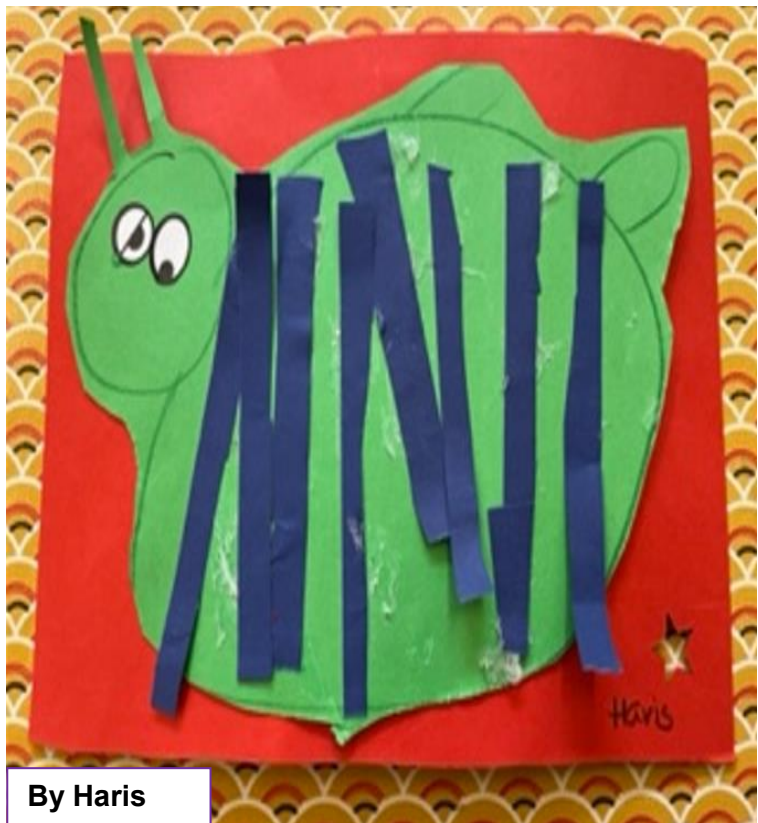

Children in Early Years been learning about jungles, water, garden animals and more this term. Children used different art materials to draw and paint animals.

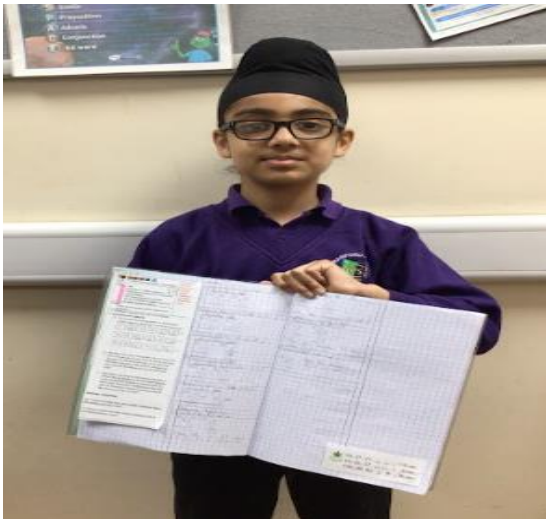
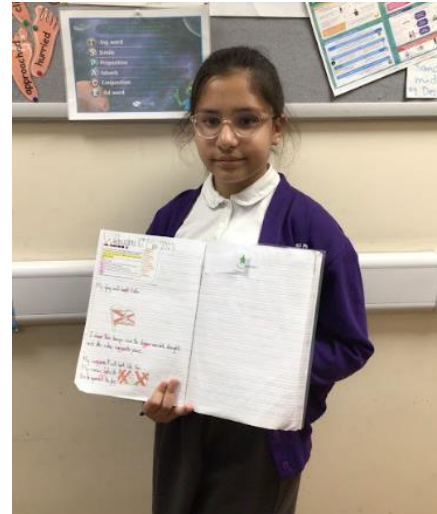


Year 4 Learning!

My Favourite Subject!

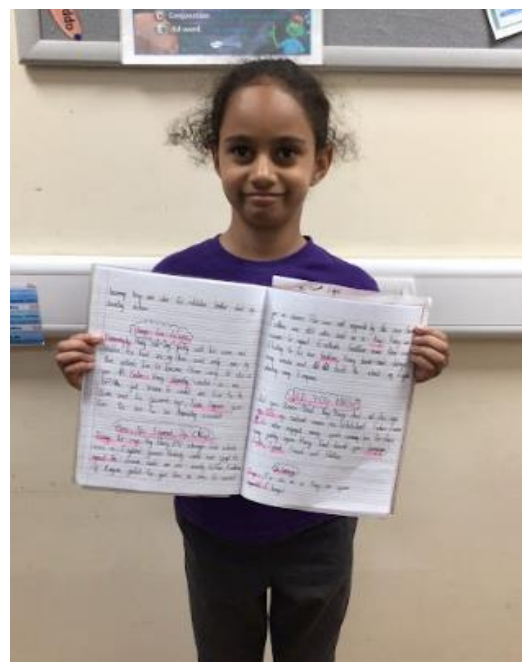
