Minnie is his best friend, she tries to help Jasper feel good about himself..


He tries to help other ocean creatures who are in danger, but they say "your useless, go away!"






My favourite lesson in school is Design Technology. We get to create and design new things. We use our imagination and make new dishes. We are making smoothies this term.

Our Forever Queen





Queen Elizabeth II


