- The school has started having different types of interventions which can be helpful to those struggling with some subjects.


- : Are there any plans in the future for expansion at our school?


#### The Dimension!




## **Stepping Back In Time: History Day!**

The Tudors were famous for many things including Henry VIII and his six wives, the exploration of America and the plays of William Shakespeare.










#### Dear Diary,

#### Dear Diary,


Dear Diary,
