
Stepping Back In Time: Legends of Time Day!

Pelé


Pelé was a legend of time because he was the first ever footballer to win three world cups.

Pelé got 3 yellow cards and 0 red cards in his whole career.


Pelé was the first ever footballer to score 1281 goals!



Halloween
