<b>Project 1 Writing</b>	<b>Persuasive Speech</b> Write a persuasive speech about a cause that means a lot to you (examples: global warming, water pollution, recycling)
<b>Project 2 Well-being</b>	Create a poster on the zones of regulations- Include examples of how we can get back into different zones.
<b>Project 3 SPAG</b>	Create your own multiple choice or true and false quiz based on subordinate clauses and embedded clauses.
<b>Project 4 Topic</b>	<b>Geography</b> Draw a map of your local area. Try to include roads, shops, parks.
<b>Project 5 Maths</b>	Create a set of instructions on how to round a number to the nearest 10, 100 and 100.
<b>Project 6 Art</b>	Create a piece of art (drawing or painting) of a place that means alot to you.
<b>Project 7 Reading</b>	Create a factfile on the water cycle. Include the different processes that happen during the cycle.
<b>Project 8 Computing</b>	<b>Computing</b> Create a set of instructions (like a computer would) on how to get from your kitchen to your bedroom in your house! Include a diagram.
