



Dear Parents and Children,

<b>Maths</b>	<p>Make your own 'Snap' game using times tables cards. On one side write the question and on the other side write the answer. See if you can get the most matches.</p>
<b>Science</b>	<p>Can you find any magnetic items in your house? Can you draw pictures of these everyday magnetic items as a poster? Include everything you already know about magnets and how they work.</p>
<b>Geography</b>	<p>Create a poster and collect facts about Heathrow Airport and the surrounding areas.</p>
