Project 1	Decide upon 5 new things that you want to try out, it could be things such as exploring a new area on your daily walk, creating a sculpture out of junk or lego, completing a crossword or sudoku puzzle, painting a masterpiece, playing a new board game or completing a challenging jigsaw puzzle, planting some flowers, learning a new recipe, learning how to knit, asking friends and family to recommend new songs to listen to, etc. Choose your five discoveries, and then go about completing them!
