Message from the Head Teacher

Please DO NOT post images of other people's children on any form of social media. It is not appropriate and some parents do not want images of their children online. Please remove any images of children in this school from your social media accounts unless you have their parents' express permission. You can, of course, share photos and videos of your own children with your friends and family via private channels such as email and WhatsApp.

Outstanding attendance and punctuality are key to your child's learning and ensure that the best possible progress and attainment levels are achieved. The school is under strict obligation to follow central government and local government guidance in relation to an absence from school. Therefore we do not allow children to take any time off during term-time. There are 13 weeks of non-school time throughout the year and this is the time during which holidays must be taken. If you have older children who attend secondary school you should remember to check their term dates before you book a holiday as term dates do not always coincide. Please note any absences occurring either side of the Easter holidays will require medical proof of illness, otherwise the absence will be marked as unauthorised.

When booking routine medical and dental appointments every effort must be made to book appointments out of school hours. The Easter break is approaching so now is a good time to book appointments with the dentist and optician.
