Year 6 Curriculum – Autumn 1

Maths

During the first half term of the year, children will consolidate their learning from previous years in Maths, as well as learning new concepts from the National Curriculum for Year 6. In Maths this half term, the children will be learning about:

- Place value
- Using all the operations
- Word problems
- Rounding
- Multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000



Year 6 Curriculum – Autumn 1

English



In English, we will be using Power of Reading and age-related books to support your child's learning. This half term, we will be studying 'Varmints'.

Everyday, teachers will ensure that areas of Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG) are taught.

Daily whole class guided reading sessions will take place as well as individual reading comprehensions.

Spelling lists will be given on a weekly basis (given out on a Monday and tested on a Friday). Every child is expected to learn them throughout the week and write a sentence for each word.

Other areas of the Year 6 Curriculum

Autumn 1

Art	3D sculpture modelling Key artist are Faith Ringgold and Henry Moore. The children will practise mix media and drawing in order to make a clay relief.
Topic	<u>Europe including Russia.</u> Children will learn to recognise countries of the world; develop an understanding of the EU; using an atlas and terms with confidence; geographical language of landscape; research countries and cities and persuading (as a Travel Agent).
Science	<u>Living things and their habitats</u> Children will enjoy learning about the parts of a plant and the habitats in which they thrive. They will also learn about animals and their habitats.
JIGSAW	Focusing on the unit 'Being Me', the children will look at their own personal qualities and their goals they wish to achieve over the next year.
