Year 5 Curriculum – Autumn 1

Maths

During the first half term of the year, children will consolidate their learning from previous years in Maths, as well as learning new concepts from the National Curriculum for Year 5.

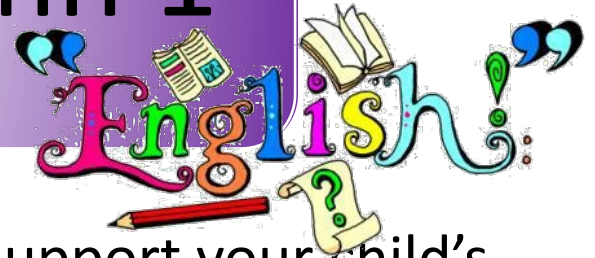
In Maths this half term, the children will be learning about:

- Place value
- Using all four operations
- Word problems
- Fractions using operations



Year 5 Curriculum – Autumn 1

English



In English, we will be using **Power of Reading** and age-related books to support your child's learning. This half term, we will be studying 'There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom'.

Everyday, teachers will ensure that areas of **Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG)** are taught.

Daily **Whole Class Guided Reading** sessions will take place as well as individual reading comprehensions.

Spelling lists will be given on a weekly basis (given out on a Friday and tested the following Friday). Every child is expected to learn them throughout the week and write a sentence for each word.

Other areas of the Year 5 Curriculum

Autumn 1

Art	Still Life Children will be learning about how to draw still life images using inspiration from artists such as Georgia O’Keefe.
Topic	<u>Geography - UK</u> Children will learn about the UK and the history of British mountains, hills, rivers seas and coasts.
Science	<u>Living things and Their Habitats</u> Children will enjoy learning about the parts of a plant and the habitats in which they thrive. They will also learn about animals and their habitats.
JIGSAW	<u>‘Being Me’</u> Children will look at their own personal qualities and their goals they wish to achieve over the next year.
