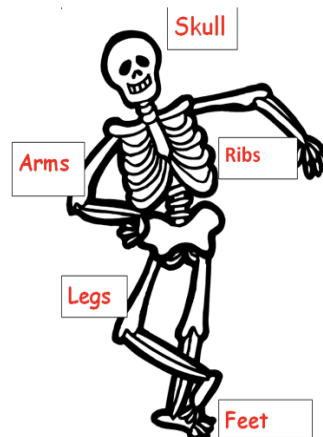




The Human body

Key Vocabulary

Skeleton – The bones of a human or an animal. Together making up the framework of the body.

Bones – The hard tissue under the skin that makes up the skeleton.

Touch – To put the hand, finger, etc., into contact with something- to feel it.

Taste – to try or test the flavour of something by taking some into the mouth.

Sight – The power of seeing objects by using the eyes.

Smell – To receive the odour or scent of something through the nose.

Hearing - To receive information by the ear.

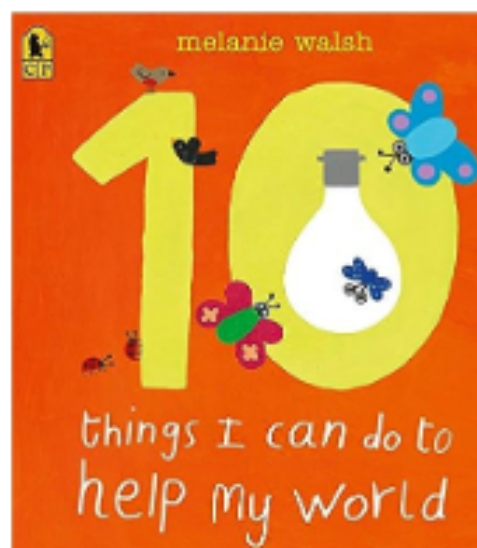

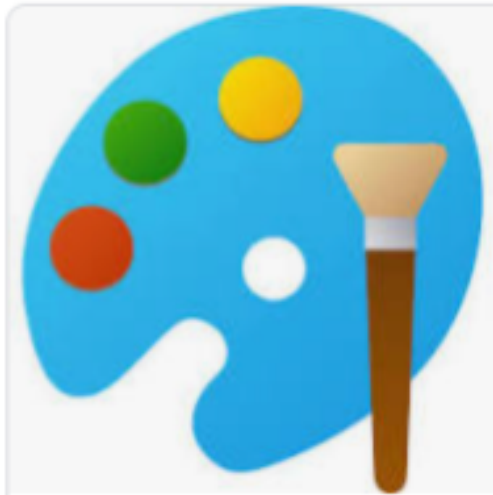

Key Vocabulary



Technology- Anything that is made by people to help us.

Log on- Creating access to a device or programme using a Username and Password.

Keyboard- Part of the computer that allows you to type words.

Mouse - Part of a computer that allows you to click and drag objects onto the screen.

Internet Safety- the process of understanding how to stay safe on the internet, e.g. by not sharing private information with anyone online.

Edit- To change something e.g. colour or size of a text.

Imagined Compositions: Drawing

Investigate: We are going to look at the work of two artists (James Ensor- Historical and Peter Doig- Contemporary) and compare their artwork and styles.

Practise: We are going to practise using paint to create colour, lines and shapes.

Progress: We are going to develop our artwork by using the skill of painting to create patterns and pictures.

End Piece: We are going to create our final piece of art by combining colour, lines and shape to paint a picture in the artists' style.

Colour

The Primary colours are three colours that cannot be made by mixing other colours. These colours are **red, yellow and blue**. When primary colours are mixed they make secondary colours.



Landscape Paintings

A landscape painting or drawing refers to an artwork whose primary focus is natural scenery, such as fields, mountains, forests, cliffs, trees, rivers, valleys, etc.

Mixed Media- using a mixture of media and processes.

***Medium-** 'singular' refers to one material an artist uses to create artwork.
