



30 hours funded childcare for 3 and 4 year olds

We now offer 30 hours Government funded free childcare for 3 and 4 year olds.

All 3 and 4 year olds are currently eligible for 15 hours a week government-funded early education the term after they turn 3 years old. But from now on 30 hours a week funded early education is available to working parents of 3 and 4 year olds.

Your child must be aged either 3 or 4 years old.

You, and any partner, must each expect to earn (on average) at least £120 a week (equal to 16 hours at the National Minimum or Living Wage).

If you, or your partner, are on maternity, paternity or adoption leave, or you're unable to work because you are disabled or have caring responsibilities, you could still be eligible.

You can't get 30 hours free childcare if you, or your partner, expect to earn £100,000 or more.

How do I apply? For 15 hours you just need to complete our Application form, but for 30 hours funding you need to apply for an eligibility code. To apply for a code parents will need to visit www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. Any parent experiencing problems applying for, or re-confirming, their code must call HMRC on 0300 123 4097 immediately.

If you do not qualify for government funding but still want full-time, quality day care for your child, we are also offering places at our Nursery, our Breakfast Club and our After-School Club at a very competitive price.

Full day Nursery: 8:45am - 3:45pm Free with code or £5.50 per hour after your free 15 hours

Lunch: 11:45am - 12:45pm £2.00 for lunchtime supervision plus £2.35 for a hot meal or you can provide your child with a packed lunch
