Our Forever Queen

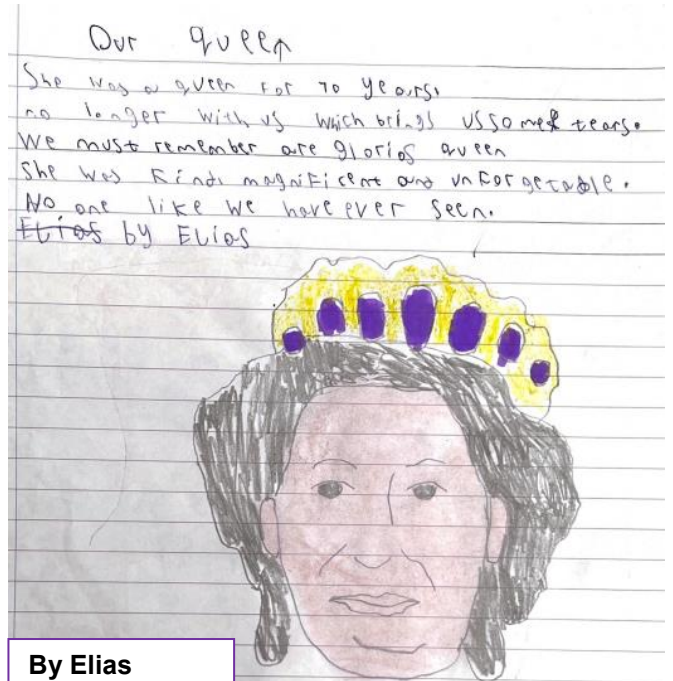

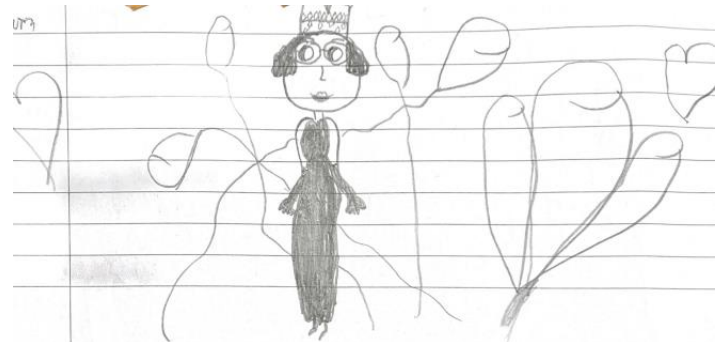
Our Beloved Queen
