Applications for Nursery 2024 are now open

Applications are now open for our school nursery. Children born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021 can start in the nursery class of our school in September 2024.

Children can take up a free 15-hour place and working families who meet certain eligibility criteria can also claim an additional 15 hours of free education and childcare a week - 30 hours in total. You can check your eligibility here.

Applications close on 8th March 2024. Please come into the school office to collect an application form.

Rights Respecting School:
