Message from the Head Teacher

Today was Legends of Time history day. The children and teachers came to school dressed up as characters from various periods in history and they joined in various activities throughout the day to help them engage with their historical learning. Each class have also been learning about a different historical figure in Black History to support our celebration of Black History Month.

We are having a Coffee Morning next Wednesday at 9.30am. All parents, carers and grandparents are invited to join us. The coffee mornings are a great way to find out what's going on in school, learn ways to help support your child's learning and to meet the staff and other parents.


