We need your views on wraparound childcare to establish demand. The Government intends to make available 'wraparound care' outside of normal school hours, so that parents of primary school-aged children can access childcare in their local area from 8am-6pm. This will include term time breakfast clubs and after-school clubs. It is intended that by September 2026, most primary schools or their partner organisations will be able to provide before and after school care. The wraparound care will be fee paying, but some parents will be able to get help with costs through tax free childcare or universal credit.

We therefore ask if you could please complete the short survey which should only take 5 minutes of your time. The deadline for completion is 4 November 2023.


I can definitely see a bright future ahead for both Imran and Aliyah!



Punctuality and Attendance

Outstanding attendance and punctuality are key to your child's learning and ensure that the best possible progress and attainment levels are achieved.

The school is under strict obligation to follow central government and local government guidance in relation to an absence from school. Therefore we do not allow children to take any time off during term-time. There are 13 weeks of non-school time throughout the year and this is the time during which holidays must be taken. If you have older children who attend secondary school you should remember to check their term dates before you book a holiday as term dates do not always coincide.

Please note any absences occurring either side of school holidays will require medical proof of illness, otherwise the absence will be marked as unauthorised.
