If your child was born between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022, they will start school in September 2026.

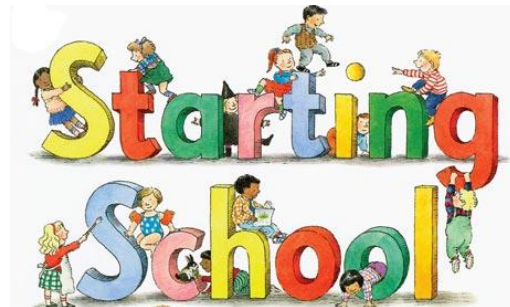
Applications are now open and will close on 15 January 2026.
