Choose one times table and design a colourful poster that teaches it in a fun and memorable way. Your poster should include facts, patterns, and creative ideas to help others learn and remember the times table. To Include - <input type="checkbox"/> Title: "Learn the ___ Times Table!" <input type="checkbox"/> Full Times Table: Write out the multiplication facts (e.g. $3 \times 1 = 3 \dots 3 \times 12 = 36$) <input type="checkbox"/> Visuals: Draw pictures or symbols that match the times table (e.g. groups of 5 stars, 4-legged animals)
Project 3 Science	Light and Shadows Create a poster all about how shadows are formed. Take photos of your shadow at different times of the day to see how it changes!
Project 4 Geography	South America! To create a South America Explorer Passport. To explore the continent of South America by creating a colourful "Explorer Passport" filled with facts, drawings, and discoveries. What to Include in Your Passport 1. Cover Page <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Title: "My South America Explorer Passport"○ Your name and a drawing of yourself as an explorer 2. Country Stamps <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Choose 3 countries from South America (e.g. Brazil, Argentina, Peru)○ Draw a flag or symbol for each country○ Write fun fact about each (e.g. "Brazil has the Amazon Rainforest!") 3. Famous Places Page <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Draw or describe one famous landmark● Write where it is and why it's special 4. Wildlife Watch <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Choose 2 animals that live in South America (e.g. jaguar, sloth, llama)● Draw them and write a sentence about their habitat or diet.
