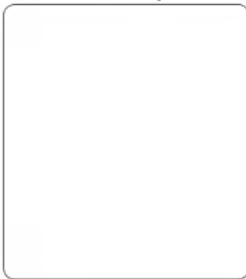
Reception Holiday Homework Activities
