




Dear Parents and Children,

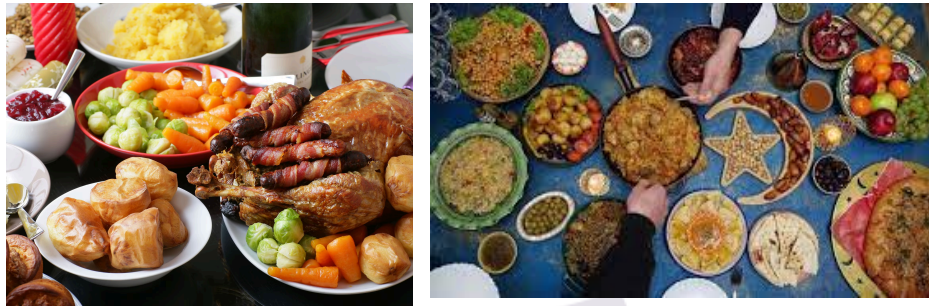
Project 5-
