Y6 Schedule

- School commences at 8.30am.
- The children must line up in their class groups ready for the day at 8.30am, where they will be greeted by their class teacher.

Maths

During the first half term of the year, children will consolidate their learning from previous years in Maths, as well as learning new concepts from the National Curriculum for Year 6.

In Maths this half term, the children will be learning about:

- Place value
- Using all the operations
- Word problems
- Rounding
- Multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000

English

In English, we will be using Power of Reading and age-related books to support your child's learning.

This half term, we will be studying 'Varmints'. Everyday, teachers will ensure that areas of Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG) are taught.

Daily whole class guided reading sessions will take place as well as individual reading comprehensions. Spelling lists will be given on a weekly basis (given out on a Monday and tested on a Friday).

Every child is expected to learn them throughout the week and write a sentence for each word.
